It is hereby notified for all concerned that the guidelines for **Exit from Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) and Five- Year Integrated Postgraduate Programme (FYIPGP)** after successful completion of Three (3) years under NEP :

1. The student who desires to exit from the FYUGP/FYIPGP after successful completion of Three (3) years with minimum 120 credits has to apply for the Exit from the current programme only through the Samarth Portal (<https://dibru.samarth.edu.in>)
2. Based on the fulfillment of the criteria for Exit, the student application shall be approved or rejected.
3. After successful completion of first Three (3) years of FYUGP/FYIPGP programme, one may apply for the Degree Certificate through Dibrugarh University Certificate Portal.
4. A student who wants to go for Betterment Examination after completion of Three (3) years has to first appear for the Betterment Examination as per the Regulation and then apply for the Exit from the current programme.
5. A student who exits from a programme cannot appear for the Betterment examination as he/she has already exited the programme.
6. A student who wishes for re-entry into a programme has to inform the University through the concerned college/department.
