NOTIFICATION

Sub: Lateral Entry Admission / Student Migration to the 3rd, 5th & 7th Semester of the Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) under NEP-2020

Academic Session: 2026 - 2027

In pursuance of the notifications issued by the Directorate of Higher Education, Assam, regarding (i) the mandatory routing of all student migrations under the Multiple Entry-Exit System, Horizontal Mobility and Lateral Entry provisions of NEP-2020 exclusively through the Assam SAMARTH Portal, and (ii) the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for Lateral Entry Admission, applications are invited from eligible students for admission/ migration to the 3rd, 5th and 7th Semesters of the Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) under NEP-2020 at DHSK Commerce College for the Academic Session 2026–2027.

All admissions shall be governed by the provisions of the National Education Policy (NEP)-2020, the Guidelines/Notifications issued by the Higher Education Department, Government of Assam, the Directorate of Higher Education, Assam, the Regulations of Dibrugarh University, and the following conditions.

1. Mandatory Online Application:

All applications for admission/migration under the provisions of Lateral Entry, Multiple Entry-Exit (MEES) and Horizontal Mobility to the 3rd, 5th and 7th Semesters shall be submitted only through the Assam SAMARTH Lateral Entry Admission Portal. No application submitted manually, offline, by email, or through any mode other than the prescribed portal shall be accepted or considered.

2. Eligibility:

Students who have successfully passed all papers of the:

- a) Second Semester for admission into the Third Semester);
- b) Fourth Semester (for admission into the Fifth Semester); or
- c) Sixth Semester (for admission into the Seventh Semester),

from a recognized Higher Educational Institution are eligible to apply for Lateral Entry/Student Migration, subject to the eligibility criteria, credit requirements, subject compatibility and academic regulations prescribed by Dibrugarh University.

3. Scope of Lateral Entry:

Lateral Entry includes admission/migration:

- a) from one Higher Educational Institution to another;
- b) from one Programme/Major to another, wherever permitted under the Regulations of Dibrugarh University; and
- c) under the provisions of Multiple Entry-Exit and Horizontal Mobility envisaged under NEP-2020.

Lateral Entry does not apply to normal semester-wise progression of a student continuing in the same Programme and Major in DHSK Commerce College.

4. Major Disciplines Offered:

For the Academic Session 2026-2027, DHSK Commerce College shall consider Lateral Entry applications only for the following Major disciplines under the FYUGP curriculum of Dibrugarh University:

- a. **Banking**
- b. **Finance**
- c. **Human Resource Management**
- d. **Marketing**

Applications for admission to any other Major subject or discipline shall not be considered.

5. Availability of Seats:

Admission shall be strictly subject to the availability of vacant seats in the respective Major discipline and the concerned Odd Semester (Third, Fifth or Seventh Semester). The College reserves the right not to offer admission in any discipline or semester where no vacancy exists.

6. Admission Procedure:

Eligible applicants for Lateral Entry shall submit their applications through the Assam SAMARTH Portal (assamadm-le.samarth.ac.in/index.php/) within the notified schedule.

Applicants shall correctly furnish:

- University/College Enrolment Number
- Name of the Institution last attended
- Programme and Major
- Semester last passed
- Academic details and credits earned
- Any other information required in the online application.

Incomplete applications or applications containing incorrect or misleading information shall be liable to rejection.

7. Verification of Eligibility:

Admission shall remain purely provisional until verification of

- Original testimonials and certificates
- Semester-wise mark sheets and credits earned
- University/College Enrolment particulars
- Eligibility under Dibrugarh University Regulations
- Subject compatibility and credit mapping
- Academic Bank of Credits (ABC), wherever applicable
- Availability of seats.

The College may require any additional document considered necessary for determining eligibility.

8. Reservation of Rights:

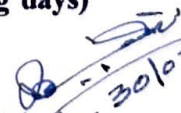
The college reserves the right to:

- determine the number of seats available in each Major subject / course and Semester;
- refuse admission where eligibility, credit requirements or subject compatibility are not fulfilled;
- modify, suspend or cancel the admission process in compliance with any direction issued by the Government of Assam, the Directorate of Higher Education, Assam, Dibrugarh University or any competent authority;
- rectify any inadvertent error or omission in this Notification.
- Mere submission of an online application shall not confer any right to admission.
- Admission shall be granted strictly on the basis of eligibility, subject compatibility, availability of seats and approval by the competent authority.
- If any information furnished by an applicant is found to be false, fabricated or suppressed, the candidature/admission shall be cancelled forthwith.
- No migration or admission processed outside the Assam SAMARTH Portal shall be recognized by the College.
- The decision of DHSK Commerce College and Dibrugarh University regarding eligibility, subject mapping, credit transfer and admission shall be final and binding.

9: General Instructions:

- Applicants are advised to carefully read all relevant Notifications, Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs), Guidelines and Regulations issued by the Higher Education Department, Government of Assam, the Directorate of Higher Education, Assam and Dibrugarh University before submitting their applications.
- All updates relating to Lateral Entry Admission shall be notified through the College Notice Board and the official website of DHSK Commerce College.
