PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE

Dibrugarh Hanumanbux Surajmal Kanoi (D.H.S.K.) Commerce College was established on 15 June, 1960, through the clear vision, great enthusiasm, and tireless efforts of prominent intellectuals and citizens of the region, along with the able guidance of eminent educationists like Dr. L. P. Dutt and Dr. N. K. Basu to become the first full-fledged commerce college in the North-Eastern region of India.

The need to introduce commerce education in Dibrugarh was recognized by the town's visionaries as early as the mid-twentieth century. To turn this idea into reality, intermediate-level commerce classes were first started at D.H.S.K. College in 1945 during the evening shift. Soon, the demand for a full-fledged commerce college was strongly felt by students, academicians, and the general public, which resulted in the establishment of D.H.S.K. Commerce College in 1960. The foundation stone of the present college building was laid by Late Morarji Desai, who was then the Finance Minister of India. Later, Dibrugarh University was established and began functioning from this newly constructed college building until 1968.

Starting from this modest beginning, the college has gradually grown into a respected institution known for its pride and academic excellence in the region. It remains strongly committed to its goals of promoting learning and achieving excellence by providing value-based commerce education, while also preparing students to meet the challenges of a rapidly changing globalized world.

D.H.S.K. Commerce College is affiliated to Dibrugarh University. The UGC recognizes the College u/s 12(b) and 2(f).

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

A. The College offers four years B. Com programme (FYUGP) in both Morning Shift and Day Shift. A student can apply only for one of the Shifts (either Morning or Day but not both) for admission. Admission Committee reserves the right to accept or reject Application Forms if an applicant applies for both the shifts.

B. **The total number of seats allotted for B. Com Program for the year 2026 is 604 (including morning and day shift). The following number of seats are earmarked according to the major subjects:**

Marketing -194

Human Resource Management-100

C. The reservation policy will be as per government guidelines.

D. Candidates seeking admission to the College are to apply through **online mode** only in the E-Samarth Portal.

E. The guidelines and procedure for admission shall be followed according to the directions and instructions issued by the Directorate of Higher Education, Assam.

G. The students will have to submit an online Anti-ragging undertaking at the time of admission.

COURSES OF STUDY

B.COM PROGRAM (FYUGP)

As per Government directive, the New Education Policy (NEP) 2020 has been implemented in the institution from the academic session 2023–24. Under this system, the undergraduate degree is offered for a duration of either 3 or 4 years, with multiple entry and exit options available during this period. Students receive appropriate certifications at each stage, such as a certificate after completing 1 year, a diploma after 2 years, and a Bachelor's degree after completing a 3-year or 4-year programme (B. Com Honours or B. Com Honours with Research) under Dibrugarh University's Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP).

M. COM. PROGRAMME CBCS (REGULAR)

The college offers M.Com. (Regular) course under Dibrugarh University, with an intake capacity of 25 students. The course is conducted through regular classes following the prescribed syllabus and guidelines of the university. Details regarding admission, class schedules, and other terms and conditions are announced on the college website from time to time.

INFRASTRUCTURE

COLLEGE CAMPUS

The college campus is housed in a well-structured three-storey building comprising 22 classrooms of varied sizes, designed to support a conducive academic environment. The entire campus is under continuous CCTV surveillance to ensure safety and security, along with well-regulated entry and exit facilities. The institution provides clean and accessible drinking water facilities, including provisions for cold water for students. The college provides well-maintained and hygienic toilet facilities separately for male and female students, ensuring privacy, cleanliness, and convenience at all times.

The campus also features two well-equipped auditoriums for hosting academic events, cultural programmes, seminars, and other institutional activities. A reliable 24×7 power supply ensures uninterrupted functioning of all academic and administrative operations. Adequate parking facilities are available for faculty members, along with limited parking space for students within the campus premises.

CLASSROOMS

The institution has 22 well-maintained classrooms that are spacious, well-ventilated, and designed for effective learning. Each classroom is equipped with modern teaching aids such as smart boards and LCD projectors to facilitate interactive and technology-enabled instruction. Classrooms are air-conditioned and under CCTV surveillance to maintain a safe and comfortable learning environment.



All rooms are ergonomically furnished with appropriate seating arrangements and sufficient capacity to accommodate students comfortably, ensuring an efficient and engaging teaching-learning experience.

COLLEGE LIBRARY

The college has a well-equipped library with a collection of 31,300 books, including 22,071 textbooks and 9,229 reference books. Students have access to important textbooks for all subjects. A reading room is also available within the library. In addition, the library subscribes to 7 newspapers, 7 periodicals, and 14 journals covering various subjects. It also provides a digital library facility with access to more than 13,000 e-journals.



○ Membership of the Library

Students, Teachers, and Non-Teaching employees of the college are entitled to become members of the library. The library remains open from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on all working days.

- i. Students are to produce their Library Cards to avail the library facility.
- ii. An overdue charge of Re. 1.00 per volume per day is levied if the book is kept beyond the due date.
- iii. Magazines, journals, periodicals, newspapers, reference books, reports, boundvolumes of periodicals and books of 'special kind' are not issued to members.
- iv. Books issued to members can be recalled at any time without assigning any reason thereof.

○ **Department Library**

Each department has its own library facility, from which students can borrow books for reference purposes.

ADDITIONAL FACILITIES

COMPUTER LABORATORY

The college has a well-equipped computer laboratory that supports both academic instruction and practical learning. The lab is accessible to students for coursework, project work, and skill development, ensuring hands-on experience with modern computing tools.

PHOTOCOPY FACILITY

A photocopy (Xerox) facility is available for students within the college library at a nominal cost, providing convenient access to academic materials and documents.

COLLEGE CANTEEN

The college provides a canteen facility within the campus, offering hygienic and affordable food options for students and staff in a comfortable environment.



GYM AND SPORTS FACILITIES

The college encourages physical fitness and overall well-being by providing a well-maintained gym facility for students. In addition, the campus includes sports infrastructure such as a basketball court and a badminton court, along with various indoor and outdoor sports equipment, all of which are available for students' active participation.



DAY CARE CENTRE

The Day Care Centre in the college provides a safe and supportive environment for the children of the staff during academic hours. It helps working parents focus on their responsibilities while ensuring proper care and supervision of their children.



HOSTEL FACILITY

The Girls' Hostel of the college is situated at Dalbir Singh Lohar Path, Khalihamari, Dibrugarh, about 1.00 km away from the college. It has a total of **75 seats**, which are allotted strictly on the basis of merit and distance from the student's hometown.

The Boys' Hostel is located at the college's second campus in Banipur, Dibrugarh. It has **10 seats** in total, and admission is also given strictly based on merit and distance from the hometown. There is also a provision of a playground for sports and other activities.

In addition, there are **2 Teachers' Quarters** in Banipur Campus and **1 Teachers' Quarter** in Khalihamari.

Admission Procedure for Girls' and Boys' Hostel

- Students willing to take admission in the hostel must submit an application available as a Google form on the college website.
- After admission, students must submit a court affidavit on stamp paper. The format for this affidavit will be provided at the time of admission.

CAMPUS PRACTICES

Ragging Free Campus

The college maintains a ragging-free and student-friendly environment on campus, including the hostel. Students are required to submit an undertaking or affidavit stating that they will not engage in ragging or any activity that may be considered as ragging. They are also expected to report immediately to the concerned authorities if they witness any such incidents. Internal Committee (IC)

The college is committed to providing a safe and secure environment for all members of the college community, especially girl students and female employees. The committee addresses all complaints related to sexual harassment and is authorized to take appropriate measures to prevent such incidents and to punish those found guilty.

Identity Card and College Uniform

Students are required to carry their Identity Card and wear the prescribed college uniform within the campus. They must attend college in proper uniform and maintain a formal dress code with formal footwear.

The uniform is as follows:

Boys: Black trousers, white and mauve striped shirt, and a black sweater in winter.

Girls: Mauve salwar, white and mauve striped kurta with mauve dupatta, or Muga-coloured mekhela with a mauve border on a white chaddar and mauve blouse with a black sweater in winter. Alternatively, white saree with mauve border and mauve blouse with a black sweater in winter.

Class Hours

Morning Shift: 6:45 A.M. to 11 A.M (With Recess)

Day Shift: 11 A.M. to 4 P.M.

Attendance

Students are required to maintain regular attendance in all classes, including lectures, tutorials, unit tests, sessional examinations, and in-semester examinations. As per the guidelines of Dibrugarh University, a minimum of 75% attendance is mandatory to become eligible to appear in the final examination.

College Examination

Students are required to appear in all class tests, unit tests, in-semester examinations, sessional examinations, and viva voce conducted by the college in order to be eligible for the final examination.

Registration

All newly admitted B. Com First Semester students are required to register with Dibrugarh University by duly filling in the prescribed registration form.

Discipline and Regulation of Students

The college aims to promote an effective teaching-learning environment along with extracurricular activities. The students have to adhere to the following guidelines:

- i. Students must maintain strict discipline and good conduct both inside and outside the college to uphold its prestige and reputation.
- ii. Students are expected to behave respectfully with teachers as well as administrative staff.
- iii. Students must maintain proper decorum in classrooms, outside areas, and the library.
- iv. Students should take proper care of college property and must not cause any damage to it.
- v. Students are accountable to the Principal for their conduct. Any act of misconduct or indiscipline will be dealt with by the Disciplinary Committee, whose decision shall be final and binding. Disciplinary action may include warning, fine, suspension from classes or examinations, or even expulsion from the college.
- vi. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited, and strict action will be taken against any student found involved in it.
- vii. Mobile phones must remain switched off during class hours. Violation of this

rule will attract penalty.

- viii. Strict action will be taken against any student found using abusive substances or possessing items such as gutka.

Payment of College Fees

The tuition fees are to be paid at the time of admission along with other applicable fees, and must be deposited digitally into the College Bank Account. The tuition and other fees are subject to revision from time to time as notified by the State Government, the University, and other competent authorities. For any updates, students are advised to visit the college website regularly.

Students' Union



The college has an elected Students' Union Body, which organizes annual sports, athletics, literary, and various cultural activities. elected student (Magazine Secretary) under the supervision of an Editorial Board headed by a Teacher-in-Charge.

In addition, students also have opportunities to contribute to the Wall Magazine (*Vasundhara*), the English Department Wall Magazine, and the Gender Champions Club Wall Magazine.

Research Publications

The college promotes high-standard academic activities and publishes an annual peer-reviewed research journal titled “*UTKARSH*” (ISSN: 2347-8381). In addition, the IQAC of the college also publishes a book every year.

Internship

Students are provided an opportunity to undertake internship in the college itself. The internship provision in the college enables students to gain practical experience alongside their academic studies. It helps them develop professional skills, enhance employability, and build connections with organizations relevant to their field.

Industry Visit
