2.3.1 Student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies are used for enhancing learning experiences.

### Response:

DHSK Commerce College has adopted a holistic approach of knowledge experience for her students by engaging students in diverse source of knowledge fields

#### A. Experiential Learning:

To make the students aware about the social responsibilities various programmes are organised at the community and village level as a part of experiential learning.

- 1. Experiential Learning through NSS: NSS provides a platform for the students to explore their own self by engaging in community work. Blood donation, Swatch Bharat Abhiyan, Cloth donation drive, community interaction, plastic collection, special NSS camp in nearby schools are some activities where the students have the opportunities to learn community and social values.
- **2. Experiential learning through NCC:** Students are given the opportunity to enroll in NCC. The NCC Unit of the college participates and organizes different programmes, rallies from time to time to sensitize students regarding social issues and create awareness among the students. The cadets are made responsible to take part in all such programmes organized by the college and play active role in holding different events.
- **3. Experiential learning through Field Visit**: Students get opportunity to take part in field trip and excursion which bring them joy and a sense of togetherness during the course of their study. Field tour on environmental awareness, participation in youth festival, Republic Day parade at New Delhi, participation in NSS and NCC camp etc in different districts and states are some of the examples which provide the students a chance to gather knowledge through experience.
- 4. Experiential learning through industrial visit, internship: The College also provides scope for industrial visit and internship to her students. In 2019, accounting and finance department organised one industrial visit to BCPL.

### **B.** Participatory Learning:

1. **Participatory Learning through Students' Union:** The College has a mechanism of electing students to form a student union each year. The sole aim of which is to promote learning by doing and inculcate leadership quality among the students. They are having different offices like

- **2. Group Learning Method**: Group Learning method is now being adopted through whatsApp group, Google classroom etc. Teacher and Student share their notes and study material through this method.
- 3. **Learning through workshop and seminars**: Numbers of workshop, seminar and talk programmes are organised per year in the college where students can have the opportunity to learn, interact and share knowledge with the resource persons from different fields.

#### C. Problem Solving Methodologies.

- **1. Interactive Teaching Learning Methods**: The faculty members make learning interactive with students by motivating student participation in group discussion, role-play, subject quiz, news analysis, educational games, discussion and questions and answers on current affairs, etc. All departments organize interactive methods of teaching in order to improve learning capacity of students.
- **2. ICT enabled tools:** ICT enabled teaching includes Wi-Fi enabled class rooms with LCD, Language Lab, Smart Class rooms, etc. The institution adopts modern teaching aids to enhance teaching-learning process. The institution has the essential equipments to support the faculty members and students. During Covid time online classes are organised and managed regularly by the teachers using number of **ICT enables tools.** Even blending mode was also practiced when the covid related restrictions on the part of the government were partially lifted.
- **3. Project methods**: The project work stimulate student's interest on the subject and provide student an opportunities of freedom of thoughts and free exchange of different views. As per the requirement of syllabi, the project work is done. For example, the Projects are done in UG and PG classes.
- **4. Student Seminars**: The Student seminars are organized where in the papers is presented by students on contemporary topics to enrich their learning experience. Summer Internship Programs are also organized by NSS for NSS/NCC students.
- **5. Black-board presentation**: In this method, students are given a certain question. And student has to solve these problems in the black-board. The department of Accountancy and Statistics generally use this method.
