# I. HOSPITALITY - FOOD AND BEVERAGE SERVICE STEWARD CERTIFICATE COURSE



## D.H.S.K. COMMERCE COLLEGE, DIBRUGARH: ASSAM

The course design includes formative tests comprising individual and group assignments (continuous classroom evaluation: 50 marks) and summative tests comprising Multiple Choice Questions towards the end of the course (written examination: 50 marks).

The course comprises of lectures (total 30 hours) aided by demonstrations with the following modules, approved by Dibrugarh University vide Notification Ref. No. DU/DR-A/6-1/22/235 dated 13/10/2022:

Module 1: Digital Literacy: 2 Hours
This module gives the basics of ICT and its various applications.

Module 2: Financial Literacy: 2 Hours
This module imparts knowledge of financial planning.

Module 3: Basics of Hotel Industry: 4 Hours

This module demonstrates the basics of Hotel industry and serving guests (Demonstration through Digital - Videos, PPTs, Voice Over and Reading Material).

Module 4: Life Skills and Self-discovery: 2 Hours

This module helps the learner to practise grit, manage conflicts, accept change and use the system-oriented approach to thinking and promotes self-reflection, growth mindset and positive attitude.

Module 5: Workplace Preparedness: 2 Hours
This module teaches resume writing, how to handle interviews and how to sustain workplace success.

[Module 6: Food and Beverage Practical (Demonstration): 18 Hours

This module includes topics that equip the learner with specific skills to work as a Steward.

HOSPITALITY - FOOD AND BEVERAGE SERVICE STEWARD CERTIFICATE COURSE conducted by DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMICS AND INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS (January - March, 2023)

On 13th of October, 2022, the Department of Economics and International Business, D.H.S.K. Commerce College received approval from Dibrugarh University to conduct the 30 hours' Add On Certificate Course on Hospitality - Food and Beverage Service Steward. The objective of this Course is to equip the learners with basic skills to perform the duties and responsibilities of a Food and Beverage Service Steward, which will help them to get into the Hospitality industry (Hotels, Hospitals, Tourism, Travel, Events etc).

Accordingly, with due approval from the College authority, an Orientation cum Induction session was conducted on 12/11/22 by the Course Coordinator, Dr Anita Baruwa, with 13 participants in online mode. A total of 7 students finally registered for the Course and classes started from 20/01/23.

The syllabus covered a total of 6 modules on Digital Literacy (conducted by Ms Sweta Bansal, IT faculty); Financial Literacy (conducted by Dr T.P. Upadhyaya, HoD, Banking and Mr Seenmoy Gogoi, B.Sc 6th Semester student with Chemistry Honours, D.H.S.K. College); Life Skills and Self Discovery (conducted by Dr Chitra Roy and Dr Anita Baruwa, faculties of the Department); Workplace Preparedness (conducted by Sangeeta Dutta, PGT teacher, Shiksha Valley School who is trained in Professional Ethics). The two modules on Basics of Hotel Industry and Food and Beverage Service Practical covered 18 of the 30 classes, which were conducted by Mr Angshumaan Borkakoti, a trained graduate in this field.

The classes were conducted in online mode as two of the students attended from outside Dibrugarh. The mode of classes included lectures, voice-overs, visual aids and demonstrations. Individual practical sessions with students were conducted as part of their formative assessment. Attendance, two assignments and practicals added upto 50 marks comprising the formative assessment. Remaining 50 marks comprised of the summative assessment in the form of MCQ based written examination, which was held in March 2023.


Out of the 7 students, 6 appeared for the summative examination and completed all the formative assessments. Mousumi Sahu secured A+ grade. Two secured A grades (Md Aman and Suman Konch) and the rest secured B+ (Abinash Borah, Sagar Paul and Aman Kumar Verma).

As part of their feedbacks, the students have suggested classes in offline mode and Diploma Course instead of Certificate Course on Food and Beverage Service Steward in the future.

### Report on Add on Course-SPOKEN ENGLISH AND SOFT SKILLS DEVELOPMENT

Offered by the Department of English, DHSK Commerce College (February – June, 2023)

As per the notification Ref. No. DU/DR-A/6-1/22/486 issued by Dibrugarh University, dated 06/05/2022, the Add on course titled "Spoken English and Soft Skills Development" offered by the Department of English, DHSK Commerce College was granted approval from Dibrugarh University to conduct the course. The course was designed to include a total of 60 hours of classes, to be held over a period of 5 months. One of the primary objectives of the course was to develop the ability of students to speak clear and correct English, with correct pronunciation and conversational structures. Moreover, this course would also prepare the learners to meet the challenges of the competitive world by enhancing their soft skills and interpersonal communications and relationships.

A total of 7 students of the college, registered for the course in January 2023. The orientation for the course was held on 10<sup>th</sup> February, 2023 in the online mode by the course coordinator, Dr. Ipsita Bhattacharyya and was assisted by Ms. Nazrana Haque (Asstt. Professor), Department of English, DHSK Commerce College. From then on, classes of a duration of 1hr were conducted in a blended mode- involving online and offline teaching for 4 days per week.

The syllabus covered a total of 4 Units On Basic Concepts Of Pronunciation And Grammar, Conversational Structures, Introduction To Communication; and Soft Skill Development. The classes were conducted jointly by Dr.Ipsita Bhattacharyya and Ms.Nazzana Haque. The course was conducted through a series of lectures, discussions and practicals. Students were graded through a combination of written and oral assessments (60+40=100 marks) - the final written exam (conducted on 2<sup>nd</sup> June, 2023 in the offline mode) was for a total of 60 marks and the rest of the 40 marks was based on their performance in speech, dialogue, everyday conversations and grammar (conducted in the online and offline mode).

Out of the 7 students, 2 students had discontinued the course and hence 5 students appeared for the written and oral assessments. Tapash Das scored A+ Grade and Ankita Sen, Samirul Islam, Abhay Gour and Mohan Lohar secured A Grade.

The last session of the course was conducted on 13<sup>th</sup> June, 2023 as an interactive session with the students- to discuss the outcome of the course and receive their feedback. All the students agreed that the course was helpful and interesting, and suggested the conduct of more practice sessions, which was not possible due to the paucity of time.
