1.1.1 Institution has the mechanism for well planned curriculum delivery and documentation

Response: Being affiliated to Dibrugarh University, the institution follows the curriculum provided by Dibrugarh University for UG and PG courses and accordingly **departmental teaching plans** and **class routines** are prepared. The **academic plan** of the College is prepared in keeping with the academic plan of the University



Remedial and tutorial classes are slotted in the class routine for slow learners and eager students and accordingly remedial classes are undertaken.



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In the beginning of the new academic session **induction programmes** are organized for newly enrolled students where students are acquainted with their semester courses as well as College and University regulations.

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Syllabi, reading lists and question banks are supplied to the students by the respective teachers and department. Question papers are stored digitally for easy access of the students. The departments maintain the following records to keep track of classes taken, topics taught and students' progression.

All the Department Heads discuss about the progress of the course with the Department faculty regularly in the **Departmental Committee Meetings**. Students are asked if they are getting suitable books and references/other study materials related to the topics taught in class. Teachers help students by supplying necessary books from the departmental library and e-resources as and when necessary. In order to test the curriculum delivery and its impact on the student's two in-semester written tests are taken in every semester. After evaluation the answer scripts of the students are returned to them so that they can realize their individual strength and weakness and can prepare themselves better for the future exams. The marks are displayed in the Notice Boards and their performance is discussed. The answer scripts and the scores of the students are preserved in the department for onward transmission to the University if and when sought for. The faculties use innovative techniques like academic quiz, group discussion, micro teaching etc for better understanding and making the teaching attractive. To introduce the students with basic research, project work is given sometimes as a part of their internal assessment. This activity brings learning with fun on the part of the students as they generally do their project based on the field survey. Various ICT based curriculum delivery tools and online modes are being used by the teachers, particularly since the advent of Covid - 19. Faculty overcome challenges posed by corona pandemic by engaging students by online teaching with the help of online teaching mode such as Zoom meeting, Google classroom etc.



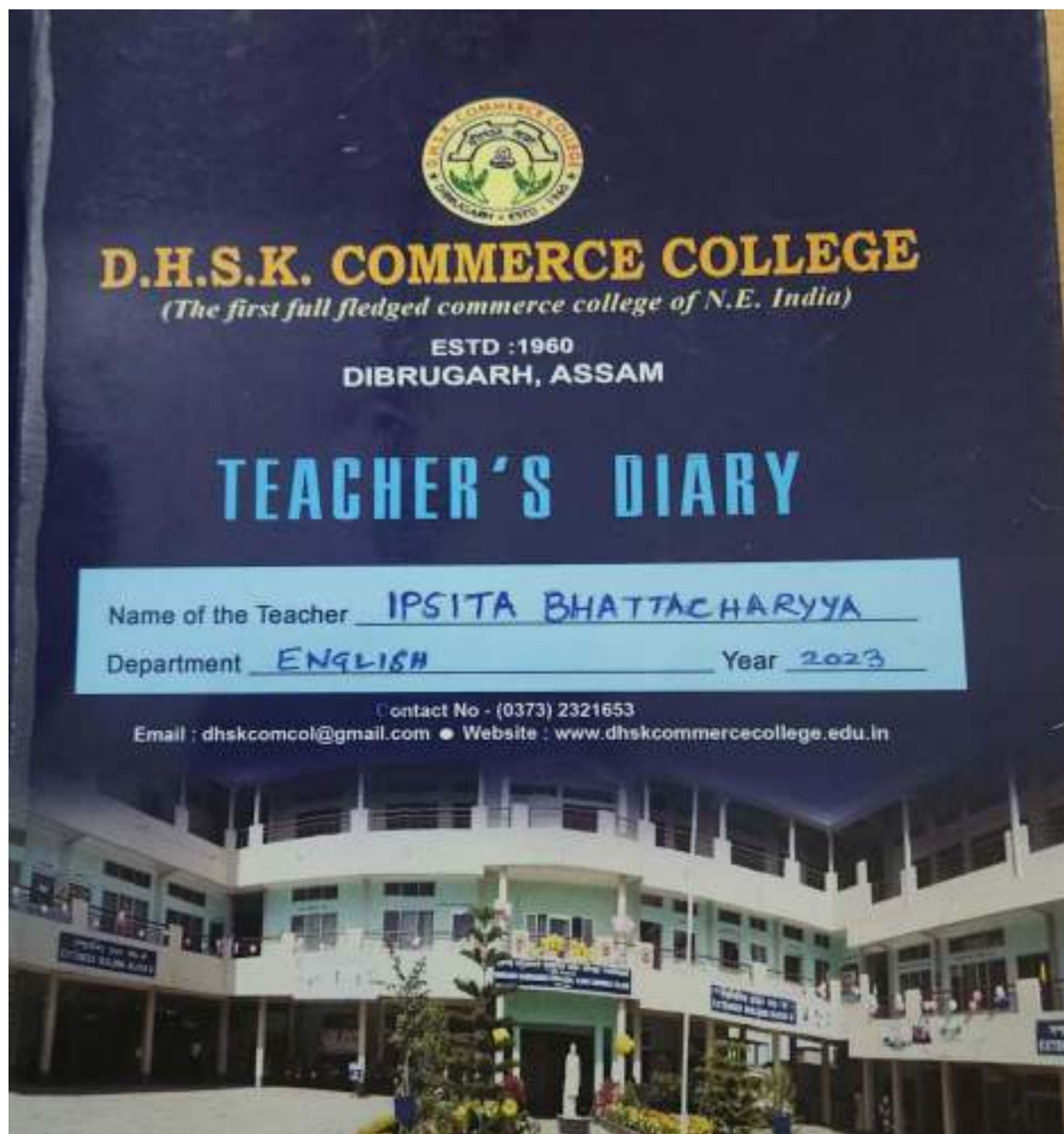
